Who can apply:

New or existing businesses whose primary office or operations are located in, or owners reside within Loveland, and who are not able to obtain bank financing

Loan Amount: Up to \$500,000*

Loan Term: Varies pending loan use and amount

Loan Uses:

Working capital, equipment, inventory, property improvements, business purchase, commercial real estate

Loan Process:

Online application on CEF website with underwriting and approval following standard CEF processes
